MERLIN-Expo is supported by CEN compliant model documentation and has been successfully tested against existing methodologies for exposure assessment.

In this workshop, you will see applications of the tool to case studies in the areas of contaminants in water, air, soil and biota systems, as well as in the human body.

The workshop will be hosted by highly regarded experts in the areas of modelling environmental fate, human exposure, pharmacokinetics and environmental risk assessment of chemicals.
